Summary of International Summer Missionary Program at CrossRoads

Purpose

International students or young people will serve as missionaries to the summer campers and staff at CrossRoads Camp & Conference Center. Campers will learn about the missionary's country, ministries, and personal faith journey through presentations and informal interaction. The missionary will build relationships with summer staff to encourage them and help broaden their view of the world and missions.

Responsibilities

1. Prepare and present a presentation about your country and the ministries with which you are involved there. Provide interactive or hands-on learning activities for the campers during the presentation. The program will be implemented three to four days of the camp week and should last about 45 minutes.
2. Be available throughout the week during activities to answer questions, speak with campers about your experiences, and participate in activities so that the campers will have opportunities to get to know you.
3. Assist with counseling campers as needed.
4. Participate in camp worship most weeks by sharing a missions story, testimony, or helping to lead music.
5. Be available to periodically lead an evening devotion for program staff or campers.
6. Volunteer in other camp programs and activities such as the camp store, talent show, recreation, etc.
7. Work within the core values and policies of Woman's Missionary Union of Virginia and CrossRoads as a growing member of the Summer Staff team.

Qualifications

1. Applicant must have been born and currently residing in a country other than the United States.
2. Applicant must have a personal relationship with Christ and be currently involved in a church or ministry.
3. Applicant must be at least 18 years old.
4. Applicant must be able to communicate effectively in English.
5. Experience working with children is preferred.
